did possess or have under the person's control any substance, device, instrument, or article, to wit: Ranger Pro Fisherman model fiberglass boat, dark grey in color with silver and dark stripes Pennsylvania Reg. PA9854EA, Hin RGR39441I122 and 2022 EZ-Loader trailer, Vin 1L83L55K1NA002081, PA. license XMK1896 with purpose to use it criminally.

FURTHERMORE, the Ranger Pro Fisherman model fiberglass boat, dark grey in color with silver and dark stripes Pennsylvania Reg. PA9854EA, Hin RG39441I122 and a 2022 EZ-Loader trailer, VIN 1L83L55K1NA002081, PA license XMK1896 involved in the offense was intended for use in the commission of a felony, to wit: 2913.02 and 2915.05.
